NOTES PRIOR TO HANDLING

USE PROCEDURES

Light duty cleaning: 1 part cleaner with 10 to 15 parts water.

Moderate to heavy soil removal: 1 part cleaner with 3 to 10 parts water.

Heavy greasy soil removal: 1 part cleaner with 3 to 5 parts high flash aliphatic petroleum solvent.

1. Wet surface with a spray of water then apply cleaner solution with mop, brush or non-atomizing spray equipment.
2. Allow to dwell until soil is penetrated, then agitate with mop or brush.
3. Rinse thoroughly with flowing water.

If water rinse is not available, apply with mop, brush or non-atomizing spray equipment. Start at the lowest point on the surface and work up. Allow to dwell until soil is penetrated. Agitate with mop or brush. Wipe off using clean, dry mops or cloths. Start at the highest point on the surface and work down.

Cold Weather Cleaning

Mix 1 part cleaner with 3-5 parts ethylene glycol/water deicing fluid and apply with mop brush or non-atomizing spray equipment. Start at the lowest point on the surface and work up. Allow cleaner to penetrate soil then agitate with mop or brush. Rinse thoroughly with flowing water or wipe off using clean, dry mops or cloths. Start at the highest point on the surface and work down.

PROPERTIES

- Clear, mildly alkaline, amber liquid with mild odor.

PRECAUTIONS

- Can cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged contact with skin. Use rubber gloves and other protective clothing as required.
- Do not take internally. Avoid breathing spray mist. Use with adequate ventilation.
- In case of accidental contact with eyes or skin, flood with water. If eye irritation persists, seek medical attention.
- If surface is above 140 °F, hose off with cold water before applying cleaner.
